

2020 Silver Beaver Nomination Information



The Silver Beaver Award is the highest honor the Denver Area Council, Boy Scouts of America can bestow upon a volunteer Scouter in recognition of distinguished service to youth. The recipients will not only be judged on their outstanding volunteer service with the Boy Scouts of America, but their overall service to other organizations within our community. Emphasis is on service to community, council, district and finally unit.

The nomination forms will be reviewed by a committee comprised of previously selected Silver Beaver honorees and community leaders familiar with the Scouting program. Final approval of the committee's recommendations will be by the National Court of Honor.

The awards are generally presented at the Council Annual Dinner in March. However due to Covid-19 and current social distancing guidelines, the formal recognition dates has not been set for these awards in 2021. Recipients and council membership will be notified once plans have been finalized for 2021.

In order to avoid disappointment, please do not reveal to the nominee that they are being considered for this award. Silver Beaver recipients will be notified by Certified Mail from the Council Service Center after the Silver Beaver Selection Committee has made its recommendations and final approval granted.

Eligibility:

Any registered Scouter in the Denver Area Council who is at least 21 years of age and registered with the BSA.

Nominating Procedures:

Candidates for this award must be nominated by their peers. Self-nomination disqualifies the candidate. The form can be located at www.DenverBoyScouts.org/silverbeavernominationform

A limit of 3 recommendation letters will be accepted. Nominations should include the application, 2-3 letters and no pictures. The nomination form must received no later than end of business on Monday, November 9, 2020.

4. Nominations will not be considered for current or former professional Scouters within five (5) years of their leaving employment with the BSA. Other council employees (part time or full time) are eligible to receive the Silver Beaver Award based on their volunteer service, not employed service.
5. Nominations cannot be considered for posthumous awards.
6. Order Silver Beaver insignia using the regular Supply order form from the Supply Group distribution center.

RULES AND REGULATIONS of the BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA

Article X, Section 6, Clause 3 Silver Beaver Award

The Boy Scouts of America, acting through the National Court of Honor, may award the Silver Beaver for distinguished service to youth upon the following basis and procedure:

- a) Each local council may process their own annual allotment of Silver Beaver awards and shall send a list of Silver Beaver recipients presented each calendar year to the National Court of Honor no later than January 31 of the following year.
- b) The award is made for noteworthy service of exceptional character to youth by registered Scouters, Cub Scouters, Varsity Scouters, and Venturing leaders within the territory under the jurisdiction of a local council.
- c) As evidence of the award there shall be presented: a suitable certificate, duly authenticated by the Boy Scouts of America, pursuant to the action of the National Court of Honor; and a miniature Silver Beaver suspended by a blue, white, and blue ribbon to be worn around the neck.
- d) It shall be a general policy that no public announcements shall be made by the local council in advance of action by the National Court of Honor with reference to names presented for consideration.
- e) These awards shall be made to the recipients by the local council concerned in connection with its annual meeting or other public location.
- f) Each duly chartered local council shall be entitled to one nomination. Councils having more than 60 units shall be entitled to further nominations on the basis of one for each additional 60 units or fraction thereof in their territory, as of December 31 preceding the nomination, according to the records of the national office.
- g) Councils not using their full allotment in any year may accumulate the unused portion for use in any subsequent year.
- h) In extraordinary cases, the Silver Beaver Award may be made by the National Court of Honor to a Scouter upon the recommendation of the duly constituted Scouting authorities having supervision of one or more units of the Boy Scouts of America, located outside of the United States and not under the jurisdiction of a local council.
