ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Serve as a backup to the Scoutmaster in his/her absence.
- Share administration duties among other Assistant Scoutmasters.
- Participate in staff training sessions.
- Report and resolve issues with the Scoutmaster. Report all issues with participants or staff to the MSR Ranch Director immediately.
- Assist with the inventory and distribution of supplies, materials and food.
- Be familiar with the camp emergency procedures.
- Help recruit quality adult and youth staff members. Ensure required paperwork is completed by all staff prior to their arrival to camp.
- Help recruit youth participants.
- Conduct the course as outlined in the BSA NYLT syllabus and manual.
- Serve as mentor and coach to the youth leader and other NYLT youth staff.
- Other duties as assigned.
